In Self-Service, you have the ability to view and print your class schedule; view your unofficial transcript and student account information; and submit your payments online.

**Note:**

When you log into Self-Service for the first time, you will then be directed to a verification screen. Here you will be prompted to enter your system identification number, first name, last name and date of birth (to be entered in this format: mm/dd/yyyy).

The next window will ask you to **re-enter your password** (see below) and choose a security question.

Once you have entered your information, you will be directed to the Self-Service home page. From there, you may change your password. You may change it at any time using Self-Service > My Profile > Account Information > Password.
